Core Phases of the Climate Leader Mentoring Program

1. Inception

An introductory session where Project Leaders are guided to take stock of their climate project

This introductory session is a peer-guided self-assessment that will give you a more realistic understanding of your project's actual situation, valuable whether or not you decide to participate in the program.

In a group, Project Leaders assess the current strengths and weaknesses of their project and identify goals the mentoring program would support.

After the Inception session, Project Leaders are matched with a Mentor.

2. Mentoring

Project Leaders and Mentors meet and are introduced to the principles and agreements for the 3-month mentoring phase.

Leaders and Mentors agree a mutually convenient time to meet regularly – usually weekly - and either remotely or in person.

During this phase, each month all participants are invited to a Zoom session for an opportunity to discuss progress and share lessons learned.

3. Completion

Zoom conference

A professional Zoom conference where Project Leaders publicly share their project with other participants plus guests interested in supporting climate projects.

All participants in the Climate Leader Mentoring Program are volunteers; hence there are no fees.
